SUMMER 2019 APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Please complete the attached application for the Dallas Women Lawyers Association (“DWLA”) Bar Study Scholarship. One \$1,500.00 scholarship will be awarded to a Texas A&M University School of Law student who has graduated or will be graduating in May 2019 who meets the following requirements:

1. Will be studying to take the Texas bar exam in the summer of 2019;
2. Does not have a grant or a current or future employer paying for a bar study course;
3. Has demonstrated leadership and academic excellence; and
4. Has demonstrated efforts in line with the mission of the DWLA, most notably elevating the standing of women in the legal profession.

Those submitting applications are required to submit this application plus a one-page résumé, current transcript, and two (2) reference letters. Feel free to attach your answers on separate sheets. Please note the final page of the application must be signed by the applicant personally (*not electronically*). *Incomplete applications will not be considered.*

Applications must be received by March 30, 2019. Please return completed applications to the office of Assistant Dean Arturo Errisuriz or via email at aerrisuriz@law.tamu.edu. You may also return completed applications to the office of Dean Terence Cook or via email at tcook@law.tamu.edu. If deemed necessary, DWLA may interview candidates.

The recipient of the DWLA Bar Study Scholarship will be awarded by early May 2019 and the recipient will be honored at the DWLA luncheon on June 21, 2019. The scholarship recipient should plan on attending the event if possible. The scholarship should be funded no later than June 1, 2019.
